


Pregnancy, childbirth, and child-rearing

History of the Benesse Group

Founded as Fukutake Publishing Co., Ltd. in Minamigata, Okayama City. Started publication of educational materials and student pocketbooks for junior high school students.

Launched Kansai Simulated Exams for senior high school students. (Shinken Simulated Exams introduced nationwide in 1973.)

Launched Correspondence Education Seminar for senior high school students

Launched Correspondence Education Seminar for junior high school students. Announced "enculturation, computerization, and globalization" as corporate

identity (CI) at first CI review Launched Shinkenzemi Elementary School Course

Launched Shinkenzemi Preschool Course (later renamed "Kodomo Challenge"). Established the Taipei Office.

Announced "Benesse" as corporate philosophy and brand at second CI review.

1991 Completed construction of the Benesse Logistics Center in Okayama Prefecture, Japan.
